A Message from our Directors

We thought it would perhaps be a good idea to let you know what we have been doing at Healing Rooms England & Wales (HREW) during these past few weeks of lockdown and restrictions which have prevented us from engaging in the normal duties of Healing Rooms around the nation.



I think that most of us were initially in a state of shock as to the impact on the familiar ministry we all know and love and how we could continue to offer much needed prayer to the enormous needs we were witnessing around our country and indeed the world at large. In fact, a local National Prayer Line in our Region was actually reporting that their facility was so inundated that they were no longer able to take calls or respond. They were asking people to email requests and although they would pray they were unable to speak with individuals.

Prayer Line 2 hours a day, 7 days a week

We felt a strong prompt from the Lord to do something, and so, after consultation and ensuring insurances were agreed we went ahead with the help of the local HR team in Staffordshire/Cheshire and launched a pilot Prayer Line, operating two hours each day, seven days a week.

Response was slow as we for the most part are not known widely outside of the Ministry and indeed even within the wider Church community. However, this is now changing and we are encouraged that the numbers calling in are increasing and we are believing this aspect of our HREW ministry is meeting a need and will continue to expand and develop into the future.

As you may possibly be aware the HREW National Conference had to be postponed due to the lockdown and unfortunately our planned speaker Jean Luc Trachsel from the International Association of Healing Ministries (IAHM) based in Switzerland was unable to come.

Using Zoom on a wider scale in ministry

However, God had a different plan and as a result of our links with IAHM we were invited to provide an online Healing Rooms via Zoom for their International Conference. A good number of our Healing Rooms took part and we, alongside BSSM Alumni, provided for all the English speaking prayer for the whole four day event. We ministered to over 600 people in total and provided up to 25 healing Zoom rooms each evening. Wow! What a learning curve but such a blessing to be part of and to minister to people from all over the planet.

Following on from this successful partnership we have been asked to engage in a year-long Healing School for IAHM where we will be providing monthly online ministry under their umbrella. We will be out there recruiting from across our National Healing Rooms in readiness for a commencement in September 2020.

The events of the IAHM conference certainly gave us a boost in confidence to take seriously this opportunity to use Zoom on a wider scale in ministry. In fact, already there are some Healing Rooms which have been advertising and using this option. It's amazing what we will do when we are presented with no option but to jump in and give it a go!

The journey back to the so called 'normal' Healing Rooms, be they in churches, community venues or in the Marketplace such as Costa Coffee or similar is at present a rather unknown timescale, but we are excited about the future and how God is using what the enemy would use to try and take us out, for His good and His purposes.

God is Moving!

Presence 2020

One of the surprising things to have come out of lockdown has been the abundant LIFE – encouragement, teaching, prophecy and intercession – that's continually being posted online. Literally it's like Jesus is laying on a feast in the midst of a pandemic! Who could have foreseen it, even 2 months ago? Can anything good come out of Covid-19? I do believe it can! His Word is clear: 'What the enemy meant for harm, God will turn right round for good.' (Genesis 50: 20) In fact, He 'works all things together for the good of those who love him and are called according to His purpose.' (Romans 8: 28) Thank you Jesus!

Earlier this year, the International Association of Healing Ministries were planning a four-day healing rally, Presence 2020, due to take place this month in Portugal. Several thousand people were hoping to attend. So was it a crying shame it had to be called off, or was it a God-given opportunity to make the conference more widely available by hosting it on-line?

In the end, over 10,000 people registered to listen to teaching, insight and revelation from more than 70 healing ministries from around the world. What a result! The interviews and teaching are still available on YouTube if you want to look them up.

Every evening a number of teams from around the world made themselves available to offer online ministry. This was Zoom on steroids, and a huge technical challenge! Healing Rooms England & Wales were invited to serve as the English-speaking team over the four nights of the conference. So as a member of this ministry I found myself serving on the Friday and Saturday nights. We were all pretty nervous. This was new ground.

Guests would first find themselves in a waiting 'room' where they were welcomed, before being allocated to a team of two in a private prayer 'room'. On the last night I believe there were around 60 people serving with our English-speaking team. And over the four nights of the conference, our Healing Rooms team alone prayed for more than 600 people. I personally prayed with people in Australia, Malaysia, Singapore, Switzerland, France and America. It was incredible. Ironically, being caught up in a global pandemic allowed us to reach way more people than if the conference had been able to go ahead as originally planned.

When someone needed healing, we placed our hands on them 'virtually' via our computer screens and watched as Holy Spirit overwhelmed them. We saw demons manifest and cast out, sicknesses healed and the greatest miracle of all, people meeting with Jesus and giving Him their lives. We saw laughter, tears and the love of God poured out in extravagant measure.

My own three favourite experiences were, firstly, praying with Jan, a middle-aged man in Croatia – through an interpreter. He was a brand new believer who wanted to be filled with Holy Spirit.

What an awesome privilege! Then there was Helga in Germany, who had been suffering with anorexia for the last 5 years. She not only felt overtaken by peace, but actually saw Jesus standing in front of her!

And lastly there was Naomi, a mum in Japan who wanted us to pray for her four year old daughter. I could hardly believe I was looking into her living room and praying with this beautiful young woman on the other side of the world. In fact, God gave me a word of knowledge for her – though I didn't realise that was what it was at first. I kept getting the words, 'I'm preparing a table for you in the presence of your enemies'. I thought it was a bit strange – maybe inappropriate – and not having any kind of 'interpretation' I questioned whether I should share it or not. But it kept coming back so in I jumped! Turns out Naomi's mum died a few years ago after a painful battle with cancer. Naomi was bereft and confused. Her mum wasn't very old and they were both believing God for her healing.

This was the verse God gave her in the midst of her questioning — along with a powerful revelation of His goodness. It was the verse He used to draw her back to Himself. It had become her personal Word from the Father. So much so that she wrote a song about it. (She was a worship leader but had never written a song before.) Not only that but, during lockdown, she had decided to gather together a choir online to record her song. They were going to do it the following week! I am so so glad I shared with Naomi what God had given me, even though it made no sense until she shared her story. Don't we have an amazing Dad? He not only affirmed to Naomi that He really does know the plans He has for her, He also encouraged me that He wants to use me to touch lives, whether in Crewe or in Japan. All we have to do is trust Him and jump in!

What an awesome Father we have!

What an awesome Father we have! I am so grateful for all the opportunities He gives us to love Him and love one another. In the midst of a global pandemic He prepares a banquet for us while our enemies watch. Boom. That's Jesus.

Looking to the Future

HREW have been invited by IAHM to partner with them in providing an English speaking Zoom Healing Rooms over an initial twelve month period. This would take place once per month and would be alongside an evening of teaching run by IAHM. This is an exciting opportunity and given trustees and insurance agreement would wish to pursue.

Also, partnering with BSSM Alumni from around the world, added an extra dimension to our ministry at the Presence 2020 Conference and we would be eager to build on this into the future.

Exciting times!! Please pray that this is in line with the Father's will.

Testimonies from Presence 2020 Conference

These are a sample from some of the many hundreds of visits to the English-speaking Prayer Rooms. Names have been changed.

I prayed with a lady called Jo from Switzerland – She was bed bound, multiple areas of pain and discomfort, incredibly sad, depressed through lack of human contact during lock down. Using IT, she had started listening to Christian broadcasts and discovered the conference online. She willingly committed her life to Jesus, we were able to pray for God's light, comfort, hope and healing. The change in her face from the start to the end was amazing. We left her smiling and glowing.

Julie from the USA had excruciating pain in her neck. We asked her to place her hands on her neck where the pain was. As we were praying, Beth, with hands on her neck and slowly rotating her head, started laughing and when Janice asked what was happening Beth said "WOW! The pain has gone, it suddenly lifted!"

A young Asian lady had a wrist too painful to use. We laid hands on the screen – instant healing. It took 4 mins!

The first person we prayed with had received prayer the night before for eczema and had experienced a partial healing, he showed us his arms which were still very red and itchy. After we prayed he said the itching had stopped and he again showed us his arms which were now clear of any blemishes or redness.

Healing Rooms at Costa Coffee

Healing Rooms meetings are suspended until such time as Costa Coffee are open again. We are still open for any prayer requests which will be passed to the team as is deemed appropriate. If you have prayer needs, then pass them to us using the contact details on the websites.

HREW are continuing to offer prayer at various locations, however, at present our dedicated teams will pray for you either online or over the phone. We have temporarily closed our Healing Rooms to comply with and support the current Government guidance and legislation. By every means possible we must all do our best to protect the health and safety of the people in our nation at this time. We are currently not able to send out prayer cloths.
